To complete your application:

1. Assemble a completed application packet, to include:

1. Your completed Central Texas - Fort Hood Chapter 2012 Scholarship Program Application (see below).
2. Official transcript of your latest high school, vocational school or college grades, ***to include*** ACT/SAR scores and school, college or university letter of acceptance.
3. Letters of Recommendation (up to five), each created and dated during CY2012.
4. List of Personal Awards, Honors and Recognitions.
5. Your essay of not more than 500 words on the topic: What characteristics do you look for in a candidate for "Commander in Chief"? Identify three strong characteristics and defend your choices.

2. Mail your completed application packet

Mail your completed application packet to Ms. Susan Jones, Scholarship Coordinator Central Texas-Fort Hood Chapter, AUSA, PO Box 10700, Killeen, Texas 76547-0700 so that it arrives **not later than noon on Thursday, March 15, 2012.**
